Grading and Assessment

At our school, assessments from Grade 6 to Grade 12 are based on a criterion-referenced system. Academic performance is reported using an A* to U grading scale, reflecting percentage results from key assessments. Our reports provide a holistic view by including both academic and current grades. For university applications, we issue bespoke transcripts that detail final exam grades in each subject. Importantly, we do not rank our students, ensuring that everyone is recognised for their own achievements.

IGCSE and AS Level Result Analytics 2023-24

For our Grade 12 students, their AS level results represent a midway staging post towards their full A level qualifications, which will be completed in June 2025. For our Grade 11 students, the IGCSE exams which they took at the end of Grade 10 represent their final results. We are hence delighted to share that our IGCSE students achieved a 100% pass rate, with 76% of results at A* to B grades and almost half of all results an A* or A grade. We are particularly proud of these results given that all our cohort of Grade 10 students had just one year at Harrow to complete the two-year IGCSE courses.



Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities

We offer a rich co-curricular program aimed at developing well-rounded individuals:

Awards and Honours

- **The Philanthropic and Guild Awards** recognise students who have made a significant impact in representing the school in the Arts and in Sporting Competitions.
- **The Spirit of Harrow Awards** are given to students who best represent the core Harrow values on the sport's field.
- **The Highest Achievement Points Award** is given to the student who has accumulated the most achievement points during the academic year, reflecting consistent academic effort, participation in school activities, and exemplary behaviour.
- **Subject commendations** are awarded to students who have shown exceptional dedication and excellence in individual subjects, recognising both their hard work and remarkable achievement in specific areas of study.



University Guidance Counselling

Harrow International School Bengaluru has a dedicated University Guidance Counselling (UGC) team that supports students in their journey to universities worldwide. The class of 2025 is our founding batch, who are looking forward to embarking on their higher education journey under the guidance of the UGC team. All 21 students in Grade 12 are seeking to gain places at universities in India and overseas; we have a cap of 15 universities to which they may apply.
